- Bren Group project CCN2 presented their masters project for next year. They will be doing a continuation of what the CCN1 group project started. One of their main tasks will be to evaluate Lab energy use.

Bren Group Project Presentation: Campus Sustainability Management System

- Gave presentation on their group project. The project would like to do a GIS project on the campus to determine energy, water, etc use on the campus. Then develop a Sustainable Management System (SMS).

TGIF-The Green Initiative Fund

- Student lock in fee of \$2.60 which will fund sustainability projects on campus. Lock in fee starts this fall. The fund produces about \$180,000 per year
- 80% goes to infrastructure and 20% goes to education and outreach. 80% might be a revolving fund.
- There will be a board comprised of faculty, staff, undergrad, and graduate student. This board will hear the projects and determines which project will be awarded.
