The UC Single-Use Plastics Policy aims to prohibit or eliminate the purchase and use of various single-use plastics, which are a major source of pollution, environmental degradation, and human health impacts. For more detailed information check out the <u>UC Sustainable Practices Policy</u>

- As an individual student try to bring your own reusable
- As a student organization -
 - Preferred: Use reusables that can be washed or used multiple times
 - Acceptable: Use 100% fiber-based compostable foodware products

Request <u>AS Recycling's Event Service</u> that will provide recycling, compost, and trash bins. Additionally, they will handsort through the material after the event to ensure proper disposal of materials
